Each Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship provides for full tuition, required fees and a special allocation of up to \$900 per year for required books and required equipment for four years of undergraduate study on a full-time basis leading to a baccalaureate degree at any eligible Indiana public or private nonprofit college or university.

The Carroll County Community Foundation's criteria include academic achievement; school, community and work activities; potential for success; essay; financial need; and an interview. A committee of volunteers evaluated the applications and selected the four finalists who were interviewed by the Carroll County Community Foundation Services Committee. Twenty-two Carroll County students applied for the scholarship.
